



OJSA MEMORIAL DAY CLASSIC and OSA STATE SHOW RULES

1. All Junior Exhibitors must be OJSA Members.
2. All Open Exhibitors must be OSA Members.
3. The AJSA rules for the Regional and National Classics will be closely followed.
4. Each exhibitor will be permitted to exhibit an unlimited number of head at the OJSA Memorial Day Classic/State Show.
5. No bull calves will be allowed to show in any other class, except for in the cow/calf division in the Junior show. Bull entries will be excepted for the open show, see open show entry form.
6. Heifer calves born on or prior to March 31st, that are a part of a cow/calf pair, can be shown separately. If showing in the separate class, the heifer needs to be entered as a separate heifer entry.
7. Each junior show exhibitor must participate in the Cattlemen's Quiz, Sales Talk, Public Speaking and Judging Contests to qualify for overall junior and senior division awards.
8. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal in showmanship, unless prior arrangements are made with the committee.
9. Tattoos must be legible and match the papers for the OJSA Memorial Day Classic/OSA State Show.
10. All Ohio grooming rules will be followed without exception.

OJSA QUEEN AND PRINCESS RULES

1. Princess candidates will be junior division participants. Queen candidates will be senior division participants
2. The Queen and Princess are highly encouraged to attend the following events: Ohio State Fair Open and Junior Shows, Ohio Simmental Association Annual Meeting/Banquet, Ohio Beef Expo activities and sale. Other activities may be assigned as they arise.
3. The candidates will be required to interview with a set of judges and this will be held during the OJSA Memorial Day Classic.
