We will take an hour break between Showmanship and the beginning of the Junior show.

**Bedding in the barns will NOT be provided and is limited to Straw or Shavings Only. Ohio Simmental Association will have shavings and straw available. Please indicate on the entry form if you would like to pre order and have it there. You will pay for it at check in. If you don't pre order we will still have it available. Shaving are \$5.49 per bale  
Straw – \$6.00 per Bale**

**NO Tie Outs and NO Tying to trailers. All cattle must stay in the barns. You can put your cattle in your trailer at night if you would like.** (Some have asked why and it is because the fairgrounds has hosted many jackpot type cattle shows over the years and when they used to allow tie outs then the fairgrounds was left a total mess so they will not allow us to do tie outs. We know you all like tie outs so please know that we are also sad about the fact that our fellow cattlemen have caused problems in the past so we will do our best to prove that not all are like that.)

**PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU BRING GENERATORS!!!! Bring a wheelbarrow if you can to help keep your area clean without as much work, some spots will be closer to manure collection than others. Thank You.**

Camping is \$25 per night which will be included when you check in. Please fill out that section on the entry form. They have full electric and water and a dump station on site. Please indicate the number of nights you would like to camp and we will work with the fairgrounds and be in touch with each person before the event.

# 2020 OSA/OJSA State Show

**Entry Deadline: To be sure of a spot entry Deadline is July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020. We will accept late entries if there is still room in the barns.**

**Please complete a form for each exhibitor to be registered for the show.**

**All money will not be accepted until the day of check-in on August 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup>.**

**\*Please Note all animals will need to be registered with the American Simmental Assoc. Pending or reported numbers (# in parenthesis) will not be accepted.**

**\*The show will follow AJSA Regional and National Classics rules for purebred and percentage distinction. (3/4 - 1/2 blood females will show as Percentage), Steers and Feeders will be shown by age and must be registered in a juniors names.**

**\*No pumping, painting or artificial hair allowed, we will be following all Ohio Exhibition fitting rules.**

**\*Fitting is optional but not required. Absolutely No more than 4 people at a chute at one time, per social distancing rules. Anyone can Fit.**

**\*Please be mindful of social distancing.**

**\*Please be respectful to the facility and throw your trash in the trash cans only and your manure in the manure dumpsters.**

## Entry Fees – Juniors Exhibitors

All Fees will be paid at the show.

Cattle must be registered in the Juniors name at the time of check in. Please bring the registration papers or a print out of the papers from the ASA website.

Junior Membership is \$12 per Child (ages 6-22) and with your Junior membership you can enter as many cattle as you want in the Junior and Open show for a fee of \$20 per head per show.

Example - So for a junior to enter one animal for both days would be \$52 if they have not paid the OJSA dues and \$40 if they have already paid their dues, there will be no fee to enter Showmanship.

Junior Show is Open to only Ohio/WV residents per the by laws of the OJSA.

## Entry Fees – Open Exhibitors

All Fees will be paid at the show.

Cattle must be registered in the Exhibitors name or Farm Name at the time of check in. Please bring the registration papers or a print out of the papers from the ASA website.

Adult Membership is \$20 per family and with your Adult membership you can enter as many cattle as you want in the Open show for a fee of \$25 per head.

For Example - To enter 1 head in just the Open show and you have not paid your OSA dues it would be \$45 and then each additional head entered would be \$25.

The Open show is open to any exhibitor in or out of Ohio unless the fairgrounds and local health department gives us other instructions. We keep you all posted of any changes.
